



Information from the sports coordinators

You will receive a Conformation Letter from the WPFG Rotterdam with specific information for participating in fishing. However, this information must first be viewed by the federation of the WPFG in America, which must give its approval. That could take a while. That is why we send you information that we think it is important that you already have this.

The information in the Conformation Letter will partly be the same as the information below. It will also contain additions and other topics that are also important to take in. So please also read the Conformation Letter carefully after receipt. Below our information for now.

Accreditation.

All competitors are REQUIRED to register at the Rotterdam Ahoy and receive their accreditation no later than the day before the competition begins.

See for all the specifics and the procedure all that is stated on page 12 of the Entry Book.

It's important to read that attentively for what you need to bring with you.

ATTENTION: The accreditation is therefore NOT issued at the assembly point near the fishing water.

Sending competition permit and exemption from fishing pass per mail.

We will send you the competition permits and the exemption for fishing without the mandatory fishing pass by e-mail in one of the next few days.

You must print this out and bring it with you during the training days on 23 and 24 July 2022 and the competition days on 25 and 26 July 2022.

If you also want to fish on days outside the training days and competition days, you must purchase a fishing pass for this yourself.

You can do this at a local fishing tackle shop or via the Sportvisserij Zuidwest Nederland website.

If you have forgotten to bring the permit and the exemption, you must still collect them from the information desk in Ahoy.

Meeting in Ahoy

On Saturday 23 July 2022 between 16.00–18.00 hours there will be a meeting for the fishing participants. This will take place in Ahoy in hall 2.

Here questions can be asked to the sports coordinators and the participants can meet each other.

This is not a mandatory meeting.



Fishing schedule

Training days

On Saturday 23 July 2022 and Sunday 24 July 2022 there will be two training days. The exemption from the fishing pass is therefore also valid for these days. On Sunday 24 July 2022, fishing is allowed until 4 pm. You are free to sit along the entire canal.

Match schedule for both days.

The match days are:

Monday 25 July 2022 (individual event)

Tuesday 26 July 2022 (team event)

Time schedule

7 a.m.: The participants can report to the assembly point on competition days, Dansschool Ri-Jo, Kanaalweg Oostzijde 134, 3224AD Hellevoetsluis, to check for correct accreditation and to receive the competition ticket.

ATTENTION: The participants must therefore have the Accreditation with them at the meeting point.

8 a.m.: course opens and material can be set up.

8.45 - 9.30 a.m. - feed and bait inspection.

9.50 a.m. - signal for heavy feeding, allowed until 10 a.m.

10 a.m. - signal for start competition.

3.55 p.m. - signal for 5 minutes until end of competition.

4 p.m. - signal for end of competition. Inspectors come to weigh the fish.

Competition rules attached.

We also send you the competition rules with this document. This is similar in content to what has been published on the WPMFG site, but in our opinion it is slightly more readable.

Medal ceremony

The medal ceremony for both competition days will take place on Tuesday, July 26, 2022 at approximately 8:00 PM.

This will take place in Ahoy at Medal Plaza.
